Monthly Updates

Maintenance

A new mechanic was hired named Dominick Cavello and he is fitting in very well in the role.

There have been no major equipment issues in May and the fleet is holding up very well.

The new carts have had very minor issues and are operating well.

The irrigation system has been causing some problems leading to holes 9, 15, 16, 17 and 18 only being watered from the satellite boxes on the course. The problem will be addressed when play slows down as we cannot take the chance of hitting the main irrigation line at this time.

Financials

EBITDA PTD – \$129,080 vs budget \$112,284 and last year \$123,379 EBITDA YTD – \$166,682 vs budget \$25,437 and last year \$178,096

Rounds exceeded budget by 90 and F&B gross profit exceeded budget by \$8.5k.

Mr. Washleski forecasted that June was in position to meet or exceed budget in all major revenue categories.

The Board authorized to lease the garage at the corner of Harleysville Pike and Schlosser Road from the Township for \$1,000 per month with Chairman Gifford moving to approve the motion and Mr. Bergman seconding the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
