Maintenance

Staffing is and will continue to be an issue. Projects have been placed on hold due to the lack of labor.

There will be additional dollars added to the 2022 budget to repair equipment issues that have been put off this season.

The new fountain is still waiting to be connected by the electrician.

All the carts are in good working order with only a couple minor issues.

Financials

The NOI for August was \$120,096 versus a budget of \$122,032. The average per round for the month was \$62.23 with a budget of \$57.50.

Mr. Washleski said that September was looking good as well with golf revenue currently (one week/weekend left in the month) at \$107,000 versus the budget of \$135,000. F&B revenue is at \$35,000 with a monthly budget of \$44,000.

Old Business

Signage on hole 8 is not yet installed.
