

## iRecycle App

Want to know where to recycle your recyclable materials? There's an app for that. It's the iRecycle app. This app works for Android and for your iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch, and in your computer browser. This application presents a simple-to-use interface that shows categories of recycling. A chart pops up listing 12 categories: Automotive, Batteries, Construction, Electronics, Garden, Glass, Hazardous, Household, Metal, Paint, Paper, and Plastic. From there you'll go to secondary categories. Once you've found the one you want, you get a display with information including a phone number, a link to the institution's website, a link to Maps, a checklist of other materials accepted, restrictions, and additional information. There's also a Share button so you can share the information with a friend. This app is easy to use and very helpful for finding recycling centers.
