**RESOLUTION 2025-20**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE JUNIOR SUPERVISOR PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS** Lower Salford Township Supervisors seek to educate and involve the Youth of the Township in their local government, and to reach out to involve possible future members of The Board of Supervisors, to benefit both the youth and all residents of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Junior Supervisor Program, established and fostered by Lower Salford Township, seeks to encourage the Township to have high school age Township residents participate in the workings of their local government by appointing a Junior Supervisor; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Supervisors wishes to extend to the Youth of Lower Salford Township a voice in the operation of this Township and this Board; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that:

- 1) The Board of the Lower Salford Township hereby creates the position of "Junior Supervisor."
- 2) The term of office shall be during the student's school year.
- 3) Candidates for the office shall submit a written application to The Township with a one-page cover letter highlighting the applicant's interest in the position. After considering all submissions, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint student(s) at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- 4) The Junior Supervisor shall be a Lower Salford Township resident and a high school Junior or Senior.
- 5) The Junior Supervisor shall not receive compensation.
- 6) The Junior Supervisor shall be permitted to attend all meetings of The Board of Supervisors and all committee meetings and shall be permitted to participate fully in those proceedings, except that he/she shall not be afforded the right to vote and shall not be permitted to attend executive sessions.
