OPERATIONS MANAGER:

Mr. Forwood presented his long-term project report.

Mr. Forwood asked the Board for their approval to move forward with new Truck Graphics from Landis Graphics. Mr. Scheuren suggested comparison pricing with other vendors but the Board approved if the pricing was similar.

Mr. Forwood advised the Board that with the \$225,000 grant received for the Harleysville Interceptor we will revise the scope of the project down from \$2.3M to ~\$1M and apply for more grant funding to fund another portion of the project. Plan to use pipe lining instead of open cut for this project.

Mr. Forwood advised the Board on the status of the grants awarded for the Harleysville Plant Catwalk over the clarifiers and Main Street to Carrie Lane project.

BUSINESS MANAGER:

Ms. DuBree presented the PSA received from Hofman LLC for the 0 Hoffman Road 3-lot subdivision project for the purposes of executing the PSA and establishing the TD Bank Escrow Account. Upon the motion of Mr. Bohmueller, seconded by Mr. Natale, the Board voted to execute the PSA and opening of TD Bank Escrow account by unanimous vote.
