MEETING MINUTES

March 4, 2026

The Meeting of the Board of the Lower Salford Township Authority was held on March 4, 2026, in person and via Zoom at 57 Main Street, Harleysville PA. The meeting was called to order at 7:02 a.m. by Karl Janetka, Chairman.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Upon the motion of Mr. Spause, seconded by Mr. Bohmueller, the Board voted to approve the Minutes of the February 4, 2026 meeting by unanimous vote.

OPERATIONS MANAGER:

Long Term Project Report – Mr. Forwood presented his report and noted that the Quarry Road project contract has been signed by Anrich. Mainland Ridge project will be finalized with the re-seeding in the spring Gilmore & Assoc are working on the design for the Mainland Plant centrifuge project, the design for the Manor and Alderfer Road sewer replacement project and Main Street sewer replacement between Carrie Lane Harleysville Plant.

Tyson Road Calcium Nitrate Test – Mr. Forwood described an issue with hydrogen sulfide coming out of forcemain at Tyson Road pump station which is destructive to the infrastructure and proposed a 4 month test to address the problem at the cost of \$19,000. Upon the motion of Mr. Bohmueller, seconded by Mr. Spause, the Board voted to approve the expense by unanimous vote.

Purchase of 2 New Computer Servers and Software Upgrade - \$52,330.24. Mr. Forwood presented the quote for the new production servers and new software needed and discussed the options and the need to move quickly when we receive an updated quote due to the rapid price increases that are occurring. Updated quote will be presented for approval at the next meeting.

BUSINESS MANAGER:

Ms. DuBree informed the Board that the two agenda items for 862 Harleysville Pike sewer service application and 862 Harleysville Pike PSA & TD Bank Escrow Account were not ready to be addressed because the initial review from the Authority's Engineer was not yet returned.
